Circulator instructions for Restore Freedom Initiative Petition

- **YOU MUST REGISTER** at www.RestoreFreedomMI.com and click on the 'New Circulator Application' button
- Please go to the "contact us" tab, captains and locate your nearest captain to obtain petitions and further training. If you cannot get ahold of anyone, contact restorefreedomcaptains@gmail.com or 616-303-0033 (also note, circulators do not train other circulators)
- Please join the FB Group "Restore Freedom Initiative" <https://www.facebook.com/groups/RestoreFreedomMI/>
- and our FB page <https://www.facebook.com/RestoreFreedomMI/>
- You may collect signatures from different counties. Please write the County in the line near the top of the page. Only voters registered to vote in that county may sign that petition sheet. If someone from a different county signs the petition, it may invalidate all the signatures on the page. Use a new petition for each different county.
- **VERY IMPORTANT!** When having a person sign the petition, you **MUST** have the back page touching the petition that they are signing
- The circulator may sign their own petition form.
- Use **black or blue** pen only and write legibly.
- **ONLY REGISTERED VOTERS** that are 18 years or older, and a US citizen can sign petitions. If they are not registered, they can immediately register to vote at <http://michigan.gov/vote> and, once completed, can then sign the petition.
- Circulators **MUST** witness the voter fill out the petition.
- A voter may only sign **ONE** Restore Freedom Initiative petition. (There are Recall Whitmer petitions and Repeal the 1945 Act petitions circulating, too. You can sign each of these petitions, but just be careful to sign each *KIND* of petition once.)
- **DO NOT** make copies of the petitions. If you would like more petitions, request them by contacting your local captain. If you do not get a response please contact us at restorefreedomcaptains@gmail.com or 616-303-0033.
- **DO NOT** give your petitions to anyone else to collect signatures.
- Remember when choosing where to collect signatures that all solicitation laws apply. Only circulate petitions where allowed. Ask permission when necessary.
- Please consider a donation of any size to help us cover printing costs.

PETITION DETAILS

1. The first block is the signature and the second block is the printed name. After signing, the voter must print FULL Name (same as on Voters Registration).
2. The Voter must write their address where registered to vote (NOT their polling location address, NOR the mailing address city IF they are registered to vote in a township – instead, list the township.) NO P.O. BOXES

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- a. Confusing City and Township is the most common mistake and invalidates the signature.
 - b. **To lookup voter's correct voting city or township:** Go to <http://michigan.gov/vote>
 - i. This can easily be done on a mobile device or tablet if available
 - ii. Search by Name or by driver's license number to find the correct information
3. Date is the actual date of the signature, NOT a birth date. (Example: 6/9/2020, **NOT** 6/9/20)

ADDITIONAL INFO

- Mistakes: If it is something that just needs to be clarified, ex: they put their mailing city instead of voting township, just have them add the clarification in the area. If there is no room to make the correction or they scribbled out their mistake, have them put a single line through the entire line and start fresh on the next line. If the Signature line is wrong, you must strike the entire row and have the voter complete a new row.
- CIRCULATOR: complete the bottom right portion **AFTER** you are done circulating, regardless of the number of signatures gathered. The last line of the certifications is for out of state circulators.

A proposal to amend the Michigan Constitution which, if adopted, would clarify the legal standard required in order for the government to deprive a person of life, liberty or property. Clarify the separation of powers, foundations and functions of government, rules of statutory interpretation, and the effect of emergencies on government. Enhance government accessibility, transparency and accountability. Return bill drafting to the legislators. Prohibit requirements upon employees or customers that are likely to impact health or safety, and modify the requirements to serve as judge or an examining/licensing boards, and the jurisdiction of the various state courts. The proposal is to be voted on in the November 3, 2020 General Election.

CERTIFICATE OF CIRCULATOR

The undersigned circulator of the above petition asserts that he or she is 18 years of age or older and a United States citizen; that each signature on the petition was signed in his or her presence; that he or she has neither received nor promised a reward to sign the petition more than once and has not received any reward for signing the petition; that the person signed the petition was at the time of signing a registered elector of the city or township indicated preceding the signature; and the enclosers were affixed to sign the petition.

If the circulator is not a resident of Michigan, the circulator shall enclose a notice or notices truth in the last provided, otherwise each signature on this petition shall be void. The undersigned circulator certifies that he or she is not a resident of Michigan and does not intend to become a resident of Michigan until the date of the election. WARNING - a circulator knowingly making a false statement in the above certificate, a person not a circulator who signs as a circulator, or a person who signs a name other than his or her own as circulator is guilty of a misdemeanor.
